The King's College London Centre of Construction Law offers a new one-week 2020 Summer School, covering the FIDIC standard form contracts in practice and focusing on the common and civil law legal frameworks within which these contracts are used. This intensive course is designed to equip talented commercial managers, engineers and lawyers with advanced legal, commercial and practical knowledge in relation to FIDIC contracts.

The course will be held in the prestigious East Wing of Somerset House, running from *Wednesday 10 June to Sunday 14 June 2020*. It will be led by *Visiting Professor Nicholas Gould* and *Professor Phillip Capper*, and qualifies for SRA CPD scheme and BSB CPD (ref: 1546) 30 hours.

The King's FIDIC Summer School includes lectures and workshops on FIDIC procurement and contract formation, its application in different jurisdictions, its rights and obligations and its treatment of issues such as payment, contract management, risk management, claims and dispute resolution.
